Dear Members of Trinity,

I finished reading the book "Take This Bread" by Sarah Miles. Sarah tells about her journey from being raised as an atheist to becoming a Christian. One Sunday morning she went into a church and was invited to come and receive Christ body and blood. After her first feast of Christ body she began to struggle with what does it mean to be a part of the body of Christ and especially how do you share Christ body to others. She concluded that one way she could do that was to start a food pantry in the church where she was receiving Christ body. A year after she received her first communion she was baptized and started the food pantry the same week.

Sarah shares the joys and disappointments of feeding the hungry each week. On Friday morning they would set up a bunch of tables around the altar area, fill them with food they received from San Francisco Food Bank. The numbers grew where on most Fridays over 200 people would show up for a grocery bag full of food.

Since adopting our son Joel, who was malnourished when we adopted him, I have been concerned about those who are hungry. I heard again this week the comment made by a Washington politician that the continued on page

On Saturday, Apr. 14 women of the Prairie Rivers Conference gathered for their spring conference,

In his sermon, Bishop Zellmer gave recognition to "all those women who worked tirelessly during the tough times of the 1930s and World War II to keep Lutheran churches going. Many South Dakota Lutheran churches owe their very existence to the hard work of these women."

He went on to applaud the "daughters and granddaughters" of those women for the work they do today on behalf of ELCA churches. "I applaud and recognize you for reaching this milestone of 25 years as Women of the ELCA," said the bishop.

main cause of hunger in the US is because people are lazy. She suggested that if people are hungry they should go get a job.

I get a little angry when I hear such comments. When I served as a pastor in Hatton, ND the ministerial in town ran the food pantry. We kept records on who used the food pantry and every year between two-thirds and three-fourth of the people who used the pantry were under 16 years of age. Does our representative want 8 year olds to drop out of school and go to work when they are hungry? That is what she is implying by her statement.

The other fact that became very clear was that the majority of adults using the food pantry were not lazy freeloaders but rather people who underemployed. One group was farm laborers who had work in the spring, summer and fall but they were unemployed during the winter months. These men were hard workers but had difficulty finding work in the winter and needed food. The other group of underemployed was women who worked part time because they needed to be home when their children came home from school. Most were working for minimum wages and not earning enough to feed their children, especially during the summer.

As Christians we are command by our Lord to feed the hungry. Three times Jesus told Peter to "feed my sheep" (see John 21:15-17) I believe this command was not only to feed people the Bread of Life which is Jesus but also the bread of life that is need to keep our physically bodies strong.

I am appreciative of all who contribute food items for our local food pantry. I am also appreciative to Maria Birch for organizing community food plots so people can grow some of their own food. All these efforts help to live out what if means to be the body of Christ.

Trinity will be having a "no bake" bake sale.



#### SOME THINGS TO MAKE NOTE OF


The last day of Wowsome Wednesday will be May 2, 2012. You are welcome to come hear the kids sing some of their songs at 7pm followed by ice cream.

Mark your calendars for the following opportunities to aid the 20+ adults and children attending Lutheran Outdoors Camps this summer:


