from the desk of...

Pastor Lisa

Dear Members of Trinity,

During my time at Wartburg Seminary, I had the privilege to hear one professor tell us this, when it comes to youth ministry: Faith isn't taught, it's "caught". Now, I must confess that I don't recall every detail of the class lecture that followed (sorry professor!), but those words ring in my mind as I look ahead to this year's confirmation program.

Trinity has a wonderful Christian education program Wowsome Wednesday. In it, we "catch" our young ones and help them start to explore the Bible and the Christian life as the little ones they are. As members, friends, role models, and parents in this congregation we also have the opportunity to model for them what those things look like and how they take shape in our homes and in our worship services, too. When we model the Christian life for our young people, we "catch" those kids' attention and hearts all the more

by showing them that this is a safe and healthy place where they can study the Bible, be a part of worship, and participate in activities that share the Gospel with others.

But, for whatever reason, something happens when some of our kids reach the age of middle school. They are more and more busy with other activities, and being involved in church can often get put on the back burner. And for others, confirmation runs the risk of becoming a "have to" within that list of activities. As a pastor, that's kind of disheartening. Not only are our confirmation students the future of the church---they ARE the church.

The time of learning, growing, and questioning in confirmation prepares them for a lifetime of involvement in the church, and helps solidify the foundation that began at their baptisms,
