from the desk of...



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Well, the Reformation season is upon us! At the end of the month, we will worship and celebrate together as three of our young people affirm their faith and the promises made at their baptisms, through the rite of confirmation. We as the larger ELCA (and all the rest of the Lutheran world!) will also be gearing up to honor and remember the 500th anniversary of the beginning of the Protestant Reformation as that quickly approaches in the fall of 2017. It's an exciting time in "Lutheran land", and for that, let us give thanks to God. Be on the lookout in the months to come, regarding statewide worship services that will be happening at that time!

It isn't often that I directly quote Martin Luther, but I recently came across something from him that I would like to share with all of you this month. It isn't directly tied to our Confirmation and Reformation celebrations, but I think it speaks well to whom we are the children of God here at Trinity Lutheran Church, and the ways in which we love and support one another, through the work of the Holy Spirit in and around us, during times of struggle, pain, or grief. In his commentary on Paul's letter to the Galatians, Luther wrote:

"After Christ had redeemed us, renewed us, and made us his church, he gave us no other law but that of mutual love. To love is not to wish one another well, but to carry one another's burdens—that is, things that are grievous to us, and that we would not willingly bear. Therefore, Christians must have strong shoulders and mighty bones, so they can carry their brother's weaknesses... Love, therefore, is mild, courte-ous, and patient, not in receiving, but in giving, for it is constrained to wink at many things and to bear them."

And it's a love that I see displayed so strongly in this congregation. Thank you for that, and thank God for you!

As we move into the busyness of this Reformation season, let us continue to show and share this love with one another, and all whom we encounter daily. And as the Spirit works in us to do the holy task of loving, look for the places and ways in which God is perhaps "reforming", strengthening, and guiding YOU to bear one another's burdens—to love one another in the midst of really hard things. Let those be the places where the faith, love, hope, and promises of Jesus Christ shine through. May they also guide all of us to be a stronger, more faithful, more loving congregation rooted and grounded in the promises that were made at OUR baptisms, and which we affirm right alongside our confirmands in this 499th year after the Reformation.
