Trinity Lutheran Church Council Meeting

August 6, 2017 - 10:30 a.m.

Present: Rosemary Mohr, Dave Larson, Terrold Menzie, Danny Selland, Dick Feltman

Absent: Nancy DeBoer, Sharmel Olson, Lori Tonak, Neoma Harris

Devotions: The meeting was called to order, Terrold led devotions

Additions to Minutes: No additions to the minutes

Reading of Minutes: The minutes were read and with no changes a motion was made to accept them by Dick Feltman with Rosemary Mohr seconding. The motion passed.

Treasurer's Report:

- A chart showing the ending balances of the total liquid assets since December 2015 was provided and shows a trend that stays pretty much the same over that time frame. This chart is to help show the council how the accounts are moving.
- There is still one check outstanding in the fundraising account from May 2 but after reconciling, the account balances. That check has not yet been cashed by the recipient.
- All of the other accounts balanced.
- A person was added to the payroll roster to comply with minimum wage and labor laws.
- There is a savings account at the bank that has been inactive for over two years and the bank will start taking \$5.00 a month out for fees. In order to not have to pay the fee, it is to be moved to another account that is active. It was motioned by Rosemary Mohr to transfer the money into the Fundraising account as a separate line item under the name of Savings. Dick Feltman seconded it and the motion passed.
- A motion to accept the report was made by Rosemary Mohr and seconded by Dick Feltman. The motion passed.

Correspondence:

- A thank you letter was received from one of the youth groups from Nebraska that stayed at the church.
- Got a thank you for our noisy offering to Lutheran World Relief.

Committee Reports:

PROPERTY

- Dick Feltman has volunteered to trim the bushes on the north side of the church.
- Going to rent the carpet cleaner from True Value to complete the carpet cleaning.
- The church cleanup day is to be held on August 27 after a shortened worship. The list to be handed out will include the following:
