Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With Independence Day right upon us, I find myself reflecting on not just the freedoms we have here in our nation, but how wonderfully active so many people here at Trinity are in Chamberlain and the surrounding communities. It seems like in every news article I come across, in every advertisement for community I see, one or more of you is mentioned or involved. And that is amazing to me, and here's why...

In his writing "The Babylonian Captivity of the Church", Martin Luther wrote concerning this very thing.
