Reading of Minutes:

The minutes were read and a motion was made to accept them by Rosemary with Dick seconding them. The motion passed.

Treasurer's Report:

- Fischer Rounds on worker's comp policy went up.
- The expenses outpaced income in January. However, the Treehouse check hadn't been added yet.
- There were a number of unusual one time expenses that caused the increase of expenses.
- A few accounts (Youth Group and Scholarship Fund) at Wells Fargo will be transferred to First Dakota.
