WORD

First Reading: Job 38:1-11

¹Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind: ² 'Who is this that darkens counsel by words without knowledge? ³ Gird up your loins like a man, I will guestion you, and you shall declare to me. 4 'Where were you when I laid the

foundation of the earth? Tell me, if you have understanding. ⁵ Who determined its measurements—surely you know! Or who stretched the line upon it? ⁶ On what were its bases sunk, or who laid its cornerstone ⁷ when the morning stars sang together and all the heavenly beings shouted for joy? ⁸ 'Or who shut in the sea with doors when it burst out from the womb? ⁹ when I made the clouds its garment, and thick darkness its swaddling band, ¹⁰ and prescribed bounds for it, and set bars and doors¹¹ and said, "Thus far shall you come, and no farther, and here shall your proud waves be stopped"?

Psalm 107:1-3,23-32

- ¹ O give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; for his steadfast love endures forever.
- ² Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, those he redeemed from trouble
- ³ and gathered in from the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the south.

- ³² Let them extol him in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders.

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 6:1-13

¹ As we work together with him, we urge you also not to accept the grace of God in vain. ²For he says, 'At an acceptable time I have listened to you, and on a day of salvation I have helped you.' See, now is the acceptable time; see, now is the day of salvation! ³We are putting no obstacle in anyone's way, so that no fault may be found with our ministry, 4but as servants of God we have commended ourselves in every way: through great endurance, in afflictions, hardships, calamities, ⁵beatings, imprisonments, riots, labors, sleepless nights, hunger; ⁶by purity, knowledge, patience, kindness, holiness of spirit, genuine love, ⁷truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left; 8in honor and dishonor, in ill repute and good repute. We are treated as impostors, and yet are true; ⁹as unknown, and yet are well known; as dying, and see—we are alive; as punished, and yet not killed; ¹⁰ as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing everything. 11 We have spoken frankly to you Corinthians; our heart is wide open to you. 12There is no restriction in our affections, but only

in yours. ¹³In return—I speak as to children—open wide your hearts also.
