from the desk of...

Pastor Lisa

Dear Friends in Christ,

One of my favorite parts of the day when I worked at Ne-SoDak Bible Camp was our nightly devotion time. It was a few minutes to gather with others to share highs and lows of the day, hear a word of scripture, and pray. It's a tradition that we continue, in a way, as we gather for worship during Advent to light a candle each week, pray, and hear about the coming of our Lord. Advent is a particularly good time to try out devotions with whomever you happen to share your life with at home or in your daily life, too. I encourage you to give this devotion activity a try once a week this December as we enter the season of Advent: during a meal, when you have a friend over for coffee, right before bedtime, or whenever you happen to be gathered together with other people. (You are invited to be as creative...or un-creative as you like!)

First, find five candles that you can use as an at-home Advent wreath. Tea lights placed in jars work great, and if you want to go all-out Advent-y, paint the outside of four jars blue or purple, or wrap in thin blue or purple paper. (Random fact of the day: Blue and Purple are the traditional colors of Advent. Historically, Lutherans have used blue for Advent, mainly because Northern Europeans didn't have easy access to purple dye.) Feel free to go wild to create a beautiful centerpiece wreath to have on display in the coming month, or simply set out your candles each time you gather for devotions. You'll also want some sort of box or container to hold the responses and reflections that are shared.

Whenever two or more are gathered, you may use these questions to guide your time together:

• During the week of December 2<sup>nd</sup>: light one candle and share **continued on page 4**

with one another: "What has given me hope this week?" Write down or draw what comes to mind, share your reflection with others, and put it in your box (you may all share one paper, or use individual pieces of paper).

- During the week of December 9<sup>th</sup>: light two candles and share with one another: "Where have I found peace this week?" Write down or draw what comes to mind, share your reflection with others, and put it in your box.
- During the week of December 16<sup>th</sup>: light three candles and share with one another: "What has given me joy this week?" Write down or draw what comes to mind, share your reflection with others, and put it in your box.
- On Christmas Eve day: light all four candles and share with one another: "Where have I found love this week?" Write down or draw what comes to mind, share your reflection with others, and put it in your box.
- Then, on Christmas Eve night, Christmas day, or really any of the 12 days of Christmas (before Epiphany starts on January 6), light all five of the candles, share a favorite Christmas memory with one another, and read through all the hope, peace, joy, and love that was shared over the season of Advent.

May God's blessings abound for you this Advent as we await the birth of our Savior, and live in hope of the resurrection.

# **Trinity Lutheran Church Council Meeting**

November 4, 2018 Sunday at 10:30 a.m.

**Present:** Rosemary Mohr, Terrold Menzie, Sharmel Olson, Mike Bunker, Dick Feltman, Neoma Harris, Mianna Tveit

Absent: None.

Devotions: The meeting was called to order, Terrold Menzie led the devotion.

Additions to agenda: No additions to the agenda were made.

**Reading of Minutes:** The minutes were read and a motion was made to accept them by Neoma with Dick seconding them. The motion passed.

#### Endowment Fund Update

\$2,577.00 left in the endowment fund available to use. How and what the endowment could be spent on was discussed. Also, if the total limited bond maturity fund goes below 2500.00 then we get a service charge in December unless the total of all the mutual funds is above \$50,000.00, then there is no charge. We have used some of the available endowment for a property project.

#### **Treasurer's Report**

- Nothing unusual occurred financially for the month.
- The income surpassed the expenses.
- All of the accounts balanced.
- The check from the insurance for the roof repair was deposited.
- The new proposed budget for next year was discussed. Changes for next year would include the Treehouse rent be put back to \$500 a month, Seminarian support should stay at \$1200.00, but will be set as seed money for kids going to camp, and to retain the \$1000.00 in the budget to cover the deductible for the roof repair.
- The actual expenses were compared to the budgeted amounts for each account item and for some they are close but other are off. Overall though the budgeted amounts are higher than the actual costs.
- Terrold made the motion to accept the report and Mianna seconded. The motion passed.

- Confirmation was a major highlight, as was Pastor's appreciation day.
- Disabilities Ministries would like an interview from the pastor and will try get out here for that.
- Had a number of hospital visits with some long-term pastoral care issues arising.

## **Unfinished Business**

- The wireless router was discussed and a motion was made to obtain one for \$300.00 or less with choice dollars by Neoma and seconded by Dick. It passed.
- The microphone still needs to be looked at.
- Two people are becoming new members of the church on November 17<sup>th</sup> at a Saturday evening service.

#### New Business

- The annual meeting date is set for January 27, 2019. Reports will be due January 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Three deacons and two council members will need to be replaced for next year along with the youth member.
- New Christmas decorations for the church was purchased by members of the bible study group. This totaled \$222.00. Of this amount, \$72.00 is being asked from the church to go towards this purchase. Dick made the motion to provide this from Choice dollars and Terrold seconded it. It passed.
