Pastor Lisa

Dear Friends in Christ,

My friends are some of the dearest people to me. Many are pastors or other leaders in the wider church, others work in all manner of careers and vocations. Life and circumstance has placed many of us miles upon miles from one another. Honestly, that makes me sad sometimes. I miss seeing faces I used to see every day. I am thankful that God has given us to each other in friendship for our mutual benefit, but also that we might take lessons learned from one another and continue to be friends to the people around us.

Not everyone is so fortunate to have an "anam cara", or even an acquaintance to spend a little time with. So I leave you this month to consider these things: Who are the people that God may be calling you to connect more deeply with—in an authentic, loving way? What might you/we do to show them God's love through friendship? And if you do have your own "anam cara" or two—or twenty!— how might God be directing you to foster, maintain, and build upon these friendships? The ones right in the room with you, or the ones hundreds of miles away?
