from the desk of...

Pastor Lisa

Dear Friends in Christ,

At our new bishop's, Rev. Constanze Hagmaier, installation last month she said something that has stuck with me. It's something she also said at synod assembly when delegates were preparing their votes to elect her. Bishop Constanze said something to the effect of "I am a wife. I am a mother. I am a daughter. I am a pastor. I will be the bishop of this synod. (said at installation) I am many things and have been called to many things by God. I'm not perfect, only Christ is. But I will promise to show up. To be there for the people of God in this place."

Her words both comforted and challenged me. I take great relief in her promise to be present for rostered leaders (deacons and pastors) and all of God's people in the SD synod. Her leadership and guidance will be with us all along the way. She will be present for leaders in times of joy and struggle in their ministries and lives outside of them. And I pray her ministry and leadership are fruitful.

It was her naming all of the other "things" she is that gave me pause. Bishop Constanze is a wife, mother, daughter, and has served her congregations well. She is not just one role. God has called her to "show up" in all of them. How? I wonder about that a lot as I balance my personal life and call as your pastor too. It's a challenge at times, because life and ministry happen together. It's a beautiful and holy challenge that I vowed to take on at my ordination. And I pray daily that I can do my best to "show up" for you and our mission together as disciples of Jesus Christ. Knowing I will and have failed at times, I pray for grace and strength as I find new and different ways to be present as your pastor.
