from the desk of...



Dear Friends in Christ,

As many of you may know, I'm the child of teachers. My late father taught English, History, Drama, and computers during his career before he had to retire due to his declining health. My mother spent much of her career teaching different sciences like Biology, Chemistry, and a course that helped students who weren't so science-minded to apply scientific principles to daily life. Currently, she is a resource room teacher at Selby Area high school. Even my brother teaches from time to time as an adjunct professor in ethnic studies at MN State—Mankato. And a big part of what I do as your pastor is teaching. Whether it's in confirmation, first communion, or an adult study class—to teach is a part of my call here.

So, if I'm going to be teaching, I need to continue learning! In the ELCA, pastors get two weeks of continuing education time. It's up to us to find programs, courses, or conferences to go to or participate in that serve our interests and can be applied to our service in the parish. I've really struggled the last few years to find continuing education for myself, but now I've found something pretty great and I want to tell you about it.

I was recently accepted into a Doctor of Ministry program which is tailored toward church leaders who are serving full time in parish calls or other full-time ministries. This program is called "Disability and Ministry: Imagining More Faithful and Inclusive Congregational Ministries". It is a three-year program where I will travel for about a week in May and January for intensive coursework at Western Theological Seminary in Holland, Michigan. This covers the two weeks of continuing education time. In between those two weeks, we are asked to read different assignments and do a bit of writing. These I plan to do in my down time at home.

February 2, 2020

Call to orders: Sharmel Olson **Devotions by** Pastor Lisa

Welcome to new members of council and thank you to outgoing members of council – Thank you to Mianna and Dick for their hard work and sharing their gifts with council and the congregation! Additions to the agenda: Insurance policy review, confidentiality.

Reading last month's minutes: Motion made by Neoma to amend the minutes, regarding gratuities for 2019. The minutes should have read "a motion was made by Neoma Harris to give Ron Luurs a gratuity for his IT work with the church from Thrivent Choice Dollars, motion failed due to lack of a second". That our community can see us doing life and ministry together, and that they can know that truly ALL are welcome here in the name of Jesus Christ.
