We as council also wish to offer our thanks for your continued giving and offerings. In unprecedented situations like these, that support is so important and appreciated. This week the stewardship and fundraising committee will be looking at ways we can give offering online, in addition to sending your envelopes through the mail or dropping them off to First Dakota's mail drop or at the church.
