Devotions: The meeting was called to order, Pastor Lisa led the devotion.

Additions to agenda: Nothing was added to the agenda.

Reading of Minutes: The minutes were read. Neoma made the motion to accept them, Kathi seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

- It was a month in which the collections surpassed the expenses.
- Motion to accept the report was made by Neoma and was 2nd by Terrold. The motion passed.

- Newsletter from St Dysmas.
- Received some resources for the Advent.

Committee Reports:

PROPERTY

- Looked at buying a new tree next spring to replace the dead tree in the corner. Bob or Terrold will look at removing the old one first.
- The light fixtures have been replaced.
- The roof was checked by Larson's and was found to be okay after the recent hail storm.
- Need to cut back the bushes on the north side of the building.
- New Exit Signs were installed to replace some of the ones that no longer functioned. Need to check them quarterly and keep a log.
- The shed needs new shingles and the door is crooked. The 4-H kids will be removing them and Blackwell's will be donating the shingles when they get replaced.
- The accessible parking signs are tipping over and need to be straightened.
- April's office has a broken window and needs to be repaired.
- Need the new thermostats installed.
- Neoma will be spraying for insects if needed.
- Will be promoting a Clean Up day on September 30th from 5:30 to 8:00 for a few Wednesdays, if needed, to get the list that was made fully completed to get the church cleaned up.
- The side walk should be looked at to have the surfaces evened out.

WORSHIP

- Approximately 8 individuals are becoming new members and could be possibly added the last Sunday in September. In addition, there are others who are in the deciding phase of wanting to become new members.
- Confirmation Sunday, on October 25 will still take place.
- The license was about \$234.00 for the annual license for music and for 5 months of streaming.
- Some members want to use the hymnals but the COVID CDC guidelines should be followed which recommends not to use them.
- Worship at the nursing home is still on hold but they are showing the YouTube recording of our

service each week.

STEWARDSHIP

- Would like to have the Financial Peace class sometime in January. Will discuss this during the next council meeting.
- Would like to make the church website more user friendly. Would like to have a representative
 from the Education program and WELCA to review the site to make suggestions on content for
 the website. Ron would like to update the whole site and have it work with phone access as
 well.

- Currently there is no Wowesome Wednesday being conducted. Will reassess in October to see if it can be started.
- Confirmation class is on hold as well but will also reassess during the upcoming months.

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM at the TLC Fellowship Hall.

Dave Larson opened the meeting with a devotion entitled "The Destructive Power of Unforgiveness".

Since there wasn't a meeting held in August, the minutes of the July 9, 2020 meeting were reviewed. Dave made a motion to approve, second by Alice, motion carried.

There was no Treasurer Report available, but Pastor Lisa noted that changes to the account include noisy offering and scholarship funds.

Old Business:

• Pastor reported that at the end of the month we will be welcoming 7 – 8 new members. Organizing a welcoming event is not possible at this time but something we will look at in the future.

At the new member service, the new members typically receive a gift and directory from the church. The new members are: Janet Coy, Esther Hansen, Alice Odens, Margo Heinert, Becky Johnson, and Ryan, Kristen, and Norah Brown.

- Community Needs item Pastor asked the group to let her know of anyone we are aware of that is in need of assistance during these difficult times. The church and ministerial group have assistance options as needed.
- Funday Sunday and the collection and distribution of personal items for Riverview remain on hold. The Fall School Kickoff is currently postponed.
- The Church on the Street collection is in effect and plan is to change the needs list on occasion.
- The Deacons were reminded to contact the members on their list for any updates, this is particularly important now as we will soon be receiving the new members.
- Confirmands will be recognized the last Sunday in October. Currently we have two students in the confirmation class, Declan Tveit and Evan Engel. Alice volunteered to order and pick up the boutonnieres for the Sunday service.
- Pastor will order the Thanksgiving and Christmas cards for distribution. The plan is to continue with the Poinsettia distribution. We will work with the Care Center facilities and individual members on best delivery options. This conversation evolved into a discussion on what we could do for our Care Center facilities, Riverview, Regency and Sanford. Jen commented that residents have a number of visitor and activity restrictions right now and anything we can do to lift their spirits would be great. One suggestion was sending letters Jen will let us know of other things we can do for the residents. In October we will look at Halloween treats, possibilities include individually wrapped decorated cookies, word find books, coloring books, paper. Jen will check with the other facilities and with the Sanford residents on items of particular interest. Alice will submit a request for a Thrivent Action card. We also talked about what we could do to meet the devotional needs for our member residents anticipate that quarterly we could distribute the Christ in Our Home devotionals. Jen will check on the needs of large print copies.
