Dear Friends in Christ,

On Sunday November 8th we will celebrate the affirmation of baptism (confirmation) of Evan Engel and Declan Tveit. This is a big milestone on their faith journey, and so I ask that you keep these young men and their families in your prayers as they plan for their confirmation service. It has been a joy to see them grow, and I look forward to all of the ways God will use them and their many gifts!

On Sunday November 15th and 22nd, we will have virtual worship only. With the continued rise of COVID-19 in our communities, the council wants us here at Trinity to do our best to mitigate the spread at this time. Worship on the 29th (the Sunday after Thanksgiving) is tentatively planned to be in person. Council is also asking the congregation to please wear a face mask in the church building if you are here for meetings, visits, or worship.

Concerning worship practices and office visits at this point: We will have Holy Communion for confirmation Sunday, but no other time this month. If you would like to receive Holy Communion at other times, please contact me to set up a time. If you want to come in for a pastoral visit too, please contact me and we can make arrangements. I am still available for emergencies and virtual/Zoom/ phone pastoral care. I am in my office Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.

The synod has given congregations the opportunity to meet for their annual meetings virtually, as the need may arise due to the pandemic. This requires us to meet as a congregation and vote on a resolution to be added to our constitution. So, on December 6th we will be having a short, special meeting of the congregation following worship to vote on this matter. All voting members are encouraged to attend this meeting; we will need approximately 30 people in attendance to have a quorum. This resolution is the only item that is on our agenda. Devotions: The meeting was called to order, Terrold led the devotion.

Additions to agenda: Nothing was added to the agenda.

Reading of Minutes: The minutes were read. One correction on the date of minutes was changed to Wednesday, Sep 2 at 7:00 PM. Rosemary made the motion to accept them, Mike seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

The collections were a little short this month. Hickey Heating was the only bill that was a bit higher. It wasn't sent out last month so we had to make a double payment. TLC wasn't the only one not to have received a bill last month.

The credit cards purchased from the donations during the Christmas Eve offering slowly lose value so they will be returned if possible and renewed. There are 18 left. Very little travel has been occurring so we haven't been able to provide them as in years past. Mike made the motion to cash in the remaining cards and have the funds placed in an emergency fund account to be used in the place of the cards. Rosemary seconded and the motion passed.

The 2021 budget was discussed and how COVID will affect it.

Correspondence

No correspondence was received during the month.

Committee Reports:

PROPERTY

There were still a few items requiring attention that weren't completed during the cleaning meetings. The light didn't get replaced but Donny is scheduled to replace it. The shed was partially shingled. Only the north side remains. The sidewalk still needs to be replaced. Doug Brown suggested another vendor that will be scheduled this spring. The estimate was \$1,817.14. A discussion on if this was a reasonable offer ensued and will be checked on. Another light in the sanctuary needs to be changed.

The cleaning of the shed revealed three bulletin boards, a ping pong table, two wooden easels, pulpit and some scrap boards. It was decided to advertise the items in the Chamberlain online sale site.

The new programmable thermostats will be set so that they will give the most efficient use of energy throughout the year.

Snow removal had been previously provided by Garrett George. Terrold will contact him to see if he is still willing to provide that service for the church.

WORSHIP

All Saints Day will look different due to COVID.

Will be planning for Advent soon.

Confirmation Sunday got moved to November $8^{\rm th}$.

STEWARDSHIP

The Pastor of Church on the Street sent an email inviting us to partner with them in the Mission Partner Covenant Agreement. This would include, among other things, joining them in worship at various

times of the year.

Still need to determine the dates for the Financial Class to be held in February.

Confirmation will start on Nov 4. They will be divided in half and will split time over 4 weeks. Fourteen are in confirmation class.

EDUCATION

Wowsome Wednesday will start Nov 4th as well but will only have 5th and 6th graders. Activity packets will be provided for the pre-K to 4th graders. Jeff will be working with the 5th and 6th graders.

Interested in making gift baskets for the Care Center and the Assisted Living centers in town.

Pastor's Report:

Baptism occurred and eight new members joined this month.

There will be a wedding that will occur as well next summer.

Unfinished Business:

Just need an update on the desired changes to be made on the website so they can be implemented.

New Business:

Need to start working on the Nominating Committee so that calls can start.

Will need to add procedures into the constitution on how any virtual congregational meetings will be conducted. If we have to use a virtual meeting, this will allow us to do that. It can also be applied to special meetings as well. Mike motioned the motion to move forward and have a special meeting to have this added to the constitution with Terrold seconding. The motion passed.

"Be it resolved that Trinity Lutheran Church, Chamberlain SD, amend the Constitution, Bylaws, and Continuing Resolutions by addition of C10.08 of the Model Constitution for Congregations, stating:

C10.08. This congregation may hold meetings by remote communication, including electronically and by telephone conference, as long as there is an opportunity for simultaneous aural communication. To the extent permitted by state law, notice of all meetings may be provided electronically."
