Dear friends in Christ,

Advent blessings to you! I wanted to take the opportunity here to share an update concerning our worship plans for the rest of December and for Christmas eve. Council met this morning and decided that we will gather in person and online for worship in December. The council asks that you continue to wear face mask and distance yourselves during our services. And if you or someone in your home is sick, we encourage you to worship from home.

Our Christmas eve worship is one of my favorite services we do here at Trinity. It's wonderful to see the community gather and rejoice at the birth of our Savior. We'll still do that this year, but with some important changes made out of concern and love for each one of you and your families.

On Christmas eve, you can attend our Candlelight services at 4:00 p.m. or 7:00 p.m. The council decided to "cap" each service at having 50 people gathered in the sanctuary.
