Pastor Lisa

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today the church is quiet, the temperature seems just about ready to hit sixty degrees (wow!), so my mind is on the spring season that is sure to be on its way soon. It's a change of season that it seems as though you can just "feel" or sense in so many ways. It's also Lent, a change of season in our church year. One that I think we can also sense in one way or another. The days are brighter and longer, but our hearts and minds go to the cross. To the place where our Lord suffered and died, so that he might rise and give us eternal life. What does it mean to enter and abide into this season? Wowsome Wednesday & Confirmation Class: Wednesday, 5:30 meal; 6:00 class, mid-September thru late April.


