Dear friends in Christ,

Trinity Lutheran Church Council Meeting

March 7, 2021 Sunday at 10:30 a.m.

Devotions:

The meeting was called to order, Mark led the devotions.

Additions to agenda:

New COVID recommendations guidance and how they may affect services will be added to the Worship section.

Reading of Minutes:

The minutes were reviewed. Mike made the motion to accept them, and Mark provided the second. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

- The utilities bill was dramatically higher. The cold month contributed to this. Otherwise, we are in decent spot as far as the budget is concerned. It was later noted that two bills were sent in the month of March—also contributing to the higher amount paid for utilities.
- Terrold made the motion to approve the report and Mike seconded it and the motion passed.

Correspondence:

• There have been updated recommendations for COVID and those will be discussed in new business and how they will change services.

Committee Reports:

PROPERTY

• The front sidewalk replacement obtained a bid from B2 Construction and a proposal from the committee was requested to use money from the endowment to pay for the replacement of the sidewalk. The bid came in around \$6,000.00. The committee proposed either all of it to be paid by the endowment, which saw no use last year, or to use \$3,200.00 from Thrivent and \$2,800 from the Endowment. The suggestion from the council was to use Thrivent to pay for 80% of the bid and the rest from the Endowment.

WORSHIP

- Easter Holy Week saw great attendance.
- Had first communion with 3rd and 4th grade. Around 50 attended that.
- Good Friday had great participation from the readers.

- We got a letter from the Synod on recommendations for COVID. A recommendation to make mask wearing optional was proposed and to open the pews so that all may be used. Taking the numbers of COVID cases in the county into account, the low numbers would allow the changes to take place. Dick made the motion for the changes to take place and Mike seconded it. The motion passed.
- The last meeting with the WW and confirmation kids will be on May 5th.

STEWARDSHIP

- The committee is reforming, as membership has changed a bit.
- The Ramsey classes was proposed to be changed to occur in the fall. There is still the availability for \$100.00 of the fee to be paid for, for each couple participating.

EDUCATION

- Will be finishing up on May 5th.
- Grandparents Camp will be attended by a family.

Deacons:

- Working on the gift basket for frontline workers.
- Will be meeting on Thursday to complete this.

Pastor's Report:

- Focus was Holy Week and had a lot of activities which included Easter, Lent and bible studies.
- Was invited to record a Webinar.
- The In-Person week for her doctoral program will take place from May 10th to the 16th. Will be at the meeting and gone for that week. Jeff will be filling in.

- April Noisy offering is going to the Scholarship Fund.

- The May Noisy offering was motioned to be sent to Missouri Valley Women's Crisis Center by Terrold and was seconded by Dick. It carried.
- Pastor Lisa has accepted a new position as the coordinator for ELCA Disability Ministries and will be resigning from her position as the pastor at Trinity, with her last day in the church office being May 28th, with taking remaining vacation time for 2021 through June 15th to pack and move. She submitted her resignation to the council and a motion was made by Dick to accept it with Mike seconding it. The motion regretfully passed.
