Pastor Young's Sharing Corner Hang Your Lights in Your Hearts

The first season of the church year starts with Advent, which comes from a Latin word adventus, meaning "coming." Hearing John the Baptist's cry, "Prepare the way of the Lord," we want to prepare and wait for Christ's coming. However, it is easy to lose our minds this time of year.

Thousands of voices tell us to hurry because our extra savings coupon ends tomorrow or that every Friday is Black Friday. We dash here and there. And as our house is getting decorated, we feel ready for Christmas. Soon after we find that we forgot to breathe, with too much doing. With too little being, we forgot who we are. I hear John the Baptist's cry through Macrina Wiederkehr, "O shoppers, dear shoppers hang lights in your hearts instead of on your trees. For the One we've hung our hopes on has come, and now we're free but only if we see." December is a time for transformation from spiritual darkness to encountering the light of the world.

December is also a time of singing and gift-giving. Have there been years you didn't hear "Hallelujah" chorus or didn't sing it? I am certain everybody has as "Hallelujah" chorus is one of certain songs people don't want to miss in December. Messiah has touched numerous people spiritually and fed the needy. Handel himself raised thousands of pounds for charity through Messiah concerts. Charles Burney, a historian, noted "Messiah has fed the hungry, clothed the naked, fostered the orphan more than any other single musical production in this or any other country." One writer also stated that Messiah's music and message has probably done more to convince thousands of mankind that there is a God about us than all the theological works ever written (Patrick Kavanaugh, 1996).

The meeting was called to order, Mark led the devotions.

Additions to agenda

No additions were made to the agenda.

Reading of Minutes

The minutes were reviewed. A correction to remove Aaryn Schaub from the Unfinished Business section was needed and add Mildred's last name of Reniker. Dick made the motion to accept them with the needed changes and Kathi provided the second. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report

- The expenses were normal for this time of year.
- Terrold made the motion to accept the report and Mark seconded it. It passed.

Correspondence

• A request from the American Legion for area businesses to provide a donation of \$20 a year to their organization. Dick made the motion to provide that amount and take it from the general fund. Kathi seconded it and the motion passed.

Committee Reports

PROPERTY

- There was damage done to the front door during the installation of the sidewalk. Cement was splattered on it and the attempt to scrub it off made it worse. The decision was to pay up to 90% of the bill and hold the rest back until they, the construction company, makes the repairs on it. Motion was made by Terrold and seconded by Dick. The motion passed. The 90% percent, \$6,120.00 will be taken from three accounts which includes the building account, \$2,000.00, 3,800.00 from Thrivent and the rest from the endowment fund.
- The purchase of the sound panels was discussed. An estimation on the cost was provided along with the visual representation on where they will be placed within the Fellowship Hall.
- The Zion church is still interested in purchasing the organ. They have yet to provide a bid. A discussion on it was conducted. Estimates on its value ranged from \$6,850.00 to \$10,000.00. The price of a new organ, of similar specs, was valued at \$16,000.00. A survey of the congregation on their wishes will be conducted.

• They will meet to discuss the endowment portion of the panels.

• Wowsome is doing fine as are the Confirmation classes.
