Pastor Young's Sharing Corner

"A Mountaintop Experience of Faith & Glory"



Winter is still here. Some may like this cold winter as they enjoy ice fishing. Others, like me, may enjoy this cold weather as they feel refreshed.

We are in the middle of Epiphany season. Transfiguration of Our Lord is celebrated on the last Sunday of the Epiphany season, which takes on February 27 this year.

The transfiguration on the mountain made Christ known to the disciples-- Peter, James and John-- through a vision of Jesus speaking with Moses and the prophet Elijah. Jesus' clothes turned gleaming white, and God said, "This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!" The disciples tasted a glimpse of how God would glorify Jesus at the resurrection. I hope we too experience what the disciples tasted. The disciples wanted to stay, but Jesus said they must go down the mountain and finish the work they had begun. This reminds us that we are to serve God to continue the work Jesus and His disciples started.

And then the season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on March 2. With Lent quickly approaching, I would like to communicate a few things with you.

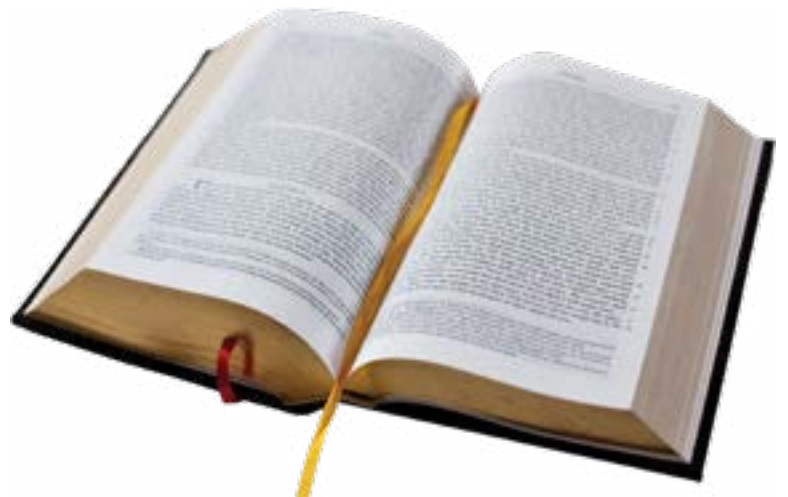
