Pastor Young's Sharing Corner

"Wrapped in the Immensity of God's Love"



Have there been times in your life when you felt a glimpse of God's first love?

The evangelist John calls God's unconditional and unlimited love God's first love! Lent is a season of soul-searching, seeking God's first love. It

is a time to lean into God to renew our faith and to meditate on the meaning of Jesus' suffering on the cross. Singing hymns can be a path for our Lenten journey in the season of love. "When I Survey the Wondrous Cross" is a meditative and prayerful hymn, on which to reflect in this season.

Isaac Watts (1674-1748, England) wrote the text of "When I Survey the Wondrous Cross" in 1707, inspired by Galatians 6:14: "May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world." It was originally sung as a communion hymn titled "Crucifixion to the World by the Cross of Christ."

The music was arranged by Lowell Mason (1792-1872, Massachusetts). Mason took the music from the first Gregorian Psalm tone. Amazingly, Mason musically painted Jesus' death on the cross using only five notes in simple, but rich and grave tones to carry the contemplative Watts' text.

The message of the cross is the power of God to those who are being saved, though it is foolishness to those who are perishing (1 Corinthians 1:18). In the Name of Jesus by Henri Nouwen, the author writes, "It seems easier to be God than to love God, easier to control people than to love people, easier to own life than to love life. [...] we have been tempted to replace love with power. [...] tempted to choose power over love." Jesus humbled himself to give up his di-





February 6, 2022

Absent: Mike Bunker and Noah Bury

The meeting was called to order by President Sharmel Olson.

Kathi Anderson shared Devotions with the group.

Bonnie Hansen, Lay Member of the ELCA Synod Council Prairie Rivers Conference attended the meeting. Ms. Hansen shared the current projects of the conference. She discussed the work being done at the McLaughlin, the splitting of the Spirit of Hope Church in Parkston and the Pine Ridge Reconciliation Center.

New/re-elected council members, Rosemary Mohr and Dotty Hieb were welcomed and appreciation for service of outgoing members, Terry Menzie and Sharmel Olson, was recognized.

Additions to the Agenda – Offering Envelopes. Discussion was held on the necessity of tracking offering envelopes. To track the contributions is tedious and considering the amount before IRS deductions can be made, in general, does not affect the member's tax responsibility. The council agreed, effective immediately, that tracking will be discontinued.

Another addition to the agenda was the Air Conditioning in the Pastor's Office. That item of purchasing another A/C was put on hold and will be considered again in the spring. The impression is that the A/C is in combination with the Heating system and should be functioning in the same manner.

The January Minutes were reviewed. Motion by Rosemary to approve, second by Mark. All in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer report was presented by Will. Will noted that a group may be coming to the church to consider the spot for a Day Care. The expenses were reviewed and questions answered. Will indicated that next month's report will reflect a couple catch up amounts totaling an additional \$2600. Dick moved to approve the Treasurer's Report, second by Kathy. All in favor, motion carried.

Election of Officers was held:

Dick moved and Dotty seconded the motion to nominate Rosemary as President. All in favor; motion carried. Dick moved that nominations for President cease. Kathy seconded motion. All in favor; motion carried. Rosemary is TLC Council President.

Dick moved that Mark be elected as Council Vice-President. Second by Kathi. All in favor; motion carried. Mark is TLC Council Vice-President.

Dick moved and Kathi seconded motion that an unanimous ballot be cast for Dotty Hieb as Secretary. Motion carried.

Correspondence: None at this time.

Committee Reports:

Property: Sharmel reported that the Zion Church will be meeting on Feb. 9th regarding purchase of the organ, a check in the amount of \$7,000 will be coming soon thereafter. Arrangements will need to be made for moving the organ to Zion. Dick asked about the designation of the funds received from the

organ. Pastor Young and Rosemary explained the anticipated purchase of a Clavinova key board and the functions of the equipment. Nancy DeBoer is researching this, the anticipated cost is \$3 - \$4K. Also noted was the positive effect of sound buffers already and appreciation to Donn and Nancy DeBoer for their work at putting them up.

Deacons: Dotty reported that new Deacon Members elected at annual meeting are Shelly Goodman, Karen Niles and Kay Hines, officers will be elected at the next Deacon meeting. 
