Pastor Young's Sharing Corner

"As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."

I would like to start with the words of gratitude. From Ash Wednesday to Mid-Week services, to Palm Sunday, and to Easter, we had more people than all previous years that attended the worship services and participated in the worship by leading songs, reading the Passion Gospel, or delivering monologues.

As we observed 40 days of Lent, we challenged our worshippers to "take on" and "give up" something to be different by Easter, practicing 40 ways to love God and love our neighbors. I hope you continue to practice some of those things on a daily basis.

During Holy Week, worshippers experienced Jesus' last week through Maundy Thursday and Good Friday worship. On Easter Sunday, worshippers learned of Mary Magdalene's surprise by finding hope amid hopelessness and becoming the first witness to the Resurrection. She became part of the Resurrection story. The good news is that we, too, are part of the Resurrection story through our baptism.

The resurrected Christ appeared to the disciples and said, "As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." (John 20: 21). The same Christ also sends us to do the work he started.

Instead of being satisfied of what we have accomplished in April, we must move forward and share Good News and serve others as Mary Magdalene went and told the disciples: "I have seen the Lord." Let's come for worship, bring Good News to those who haven't heard yet and serve those who need our hands and feet.

I earnestly invite you to discern what God is up to right now in us, in our church and in our community.


