"Jehovah Jireh" – The LORD Will Provide

We will celebrate 505th anniversary of the Reformation on October 30 through reflecting on Reformation Themes, singing of Luther's hymns, and praying with Luther's prayers.

I am excited to tell you that as part of the Celebration, five Confirmants will be confirmed on Reformation Sunday. As infants, they were baptized based on the promises of their parents to raise them in faith. Now it is time for them to confess their faith with their own tongue.

In July's newsletter, I introduced two committees – Stewardship & Worship. This month, I would like to focus on Education Committee (Judy S, Kathie, & Karen):

Throughout the summer (May-August), the committee met countless times to recruit teachers and plan for Wowsome in 2022-2023 year. I can tell you that there were times when I saw their disappointment and heard their sighs as they received only "No" or no response at all as they looked for teachers.

I encouraged them saying, "Wowsome is God's work. He will provide us with teachers. Let's stop calling but planning. We planned for Painting Party, Rally Sunday, Orientation Night, and lesson schedules as if we had all teachers for every class. Sure enough, God provided us teachers within a few weeks!
