Pastor Young's Sharing Corner December is a time for/ of ...



The first season of the church year starts with Advent, which comes from the Latin word adventus, meaning "coming." This season begins on the fourth Sunday before Christmas and ends on Christmas Eve. The traditional color of Advent is purple, a royal color for Christ the Ruler or a color for penitence. Recently blue has been recommended for use as a color of hope.

Advent has been observed in three ways regarding the "coming" Jesus in the past, present, and future. It is a time for transformation from spiritual darkness to encounter the light of the world. We prepare and wait for Christ's coming. With a sense of expectation, our sanctuary is adorned with meaningful and beautiful banners and paraments, a tree with Chrismons, and a newly purchased Advent wreath.

December is also a time of singing and gift-giving. Have you heard or sung the "Hallelujah" chorus from Messiah? Messiah has touched numerous people spiritually and fed the needy. The composer, Handel, raised thousands of pounds for charity through Messiah concerts. Charles Burney, a historian, noted, "Messiah has fed the hungry, clothed the naked, fostered the orphan more than any other single musical production in this or any other country."

Inspired by Handel's story, I hosted "Messia Sing-Along" with the Fox Valley Philharmonic orchestra in December (2011-2013), IL. Singers came from various faith communities. Through these events, a sense of community was built, the good news was spread, and the homeless were fed.

This year, Trinity will host "Bethlehem in Brule County" (A Live

Nativity & a Soup Supper) to spread the good news and benefit Chamberlain's "Helping Ends Meet" program and Kimball school's Weekend Back Pack program. I invite you to this meaningful and exciting event.

As I close my writing, I remember John the Baptist's cry, "Prepare the way of the Lord." We want to prepare and wait for Christ's coming. However, it is easy to lose our minds this time of year as a thousand voices call us here and there. Therefore, I would like to share a great call by Macrina Wiederkehr, "O shoppers, dear shoppers, hang lights in your hearts instead of on your trees. For the One we've hung our hopes on has come, and now we're free, but only if we see."

NEW BUSINESS


- Deacons will send out holiday greeting cards to the church members in early December including a schedule of events for the holiday season.

The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.


