"An Honest, Reflective Lenten Journey" (2)

Practicing the Discipline of Solitude

Dietrich Bonhoeffer said, "We are so afraid of silence that we chase ourselves from one event to the next in order to not have to spend a moment alone with ourselves, in order to not have to look at ourselves in the mirror." It is so true today as it was in Dietrich's time. We use other people, endless activity, and entertaining technology to keep ourselves from being alone.

Yet Jesus was not afraid to be alone; instead, he chose to be alone. I wonder why? Luke 5: 16 tells us that he would go away to places where he could be alone for prayer. Jesus often withdrew himself with his disciples from crowds to pray. He routinely practiced the discipline of solitude throughout his life to commune with his Fa-ther.



In this digital age, we can easily distract ourselves with noise and images from TV, social media, music, etc. In our Lenten journey, I invite you to "Give up something" (e.g., watching TV, playing video games, accessing social media) and

"Take on being alone" (e.g., reading scriptures and praying) to grow in self-awareness and relationship with God.

On Wednesdays in Lent. I will preach with the theme, "The Twelve Who Followed Jesus," and explore the Disciples' characters through Enneagram. The Enneagram is a personality typing system that helps individuals understand their unique strengths and weaknesses and how they interact with others. By examining their stories through the lens of the Enneagram, we can gain insight into our personalities and grow in self-awareness and our relationship with God. We encourage you to join us on this Lenten journey.

Minutes of 2022 Annual meeting: Read by President Mohr. A change noted that the organ was sold to Zion versus UCC. No other changes to the minutes.

- The prayer list was reviewed and updated.


