We eagerly anticipate the celebration of Easter. However, we do not simply jump straight from Ash Wednesday to Easter Sunday. Easter comes after the sleep and death of winter and after the struggle of Lent and the horrible of Holy Week. It comes, as it did for Mary Magdalene and Jesus' Disciples.

As I write this article, Lent is almost over, and now Holy Week is just around the corner. During the last five weeks, we prepared to focus on our relationship with God by attending Mid-Week services, taking up or giving up something to remind ourselves of Jesus' sacrifice, and recognizing our need for His forgiveness.

This year, those who attended the First Communion class will take their first Communion. The service will end with "Stripping of the Altar." Unforgettable disciples who delivered a monologue on Mid-Week service during Lent will appear altogether.


